The Finance group in the School of Business (SoBA) at UC Riverside (UCR) is seeking candidates for a Professor of Teaching position. It is equivalent to what is commonly referred to by many finance departments as a clinical professor. The position is officially called Lecturer with Security of Employment (LSOE) or Lecturer with Potential Security of Employment (PSOE), depending on the qualifications of the candidate.

JOB DESCRIPTION: This appointment in SoBA primarily emphasizes teaching responsibilities in its Undergraduate, Masters of Finance (MFin) and MBA Programs. Successful candidates are expected to play a substantial role in the service obligations of the Finance area, including working with student clubs and program directors to enhance the student experience. A Ph.D. in Finance or related discipline is required. Evidence of excellence in teaching is required. An LSOE or PSOE is expected to teach six quarter-based classes per year.
